Yaremche, Ukraine, June 1 - 10

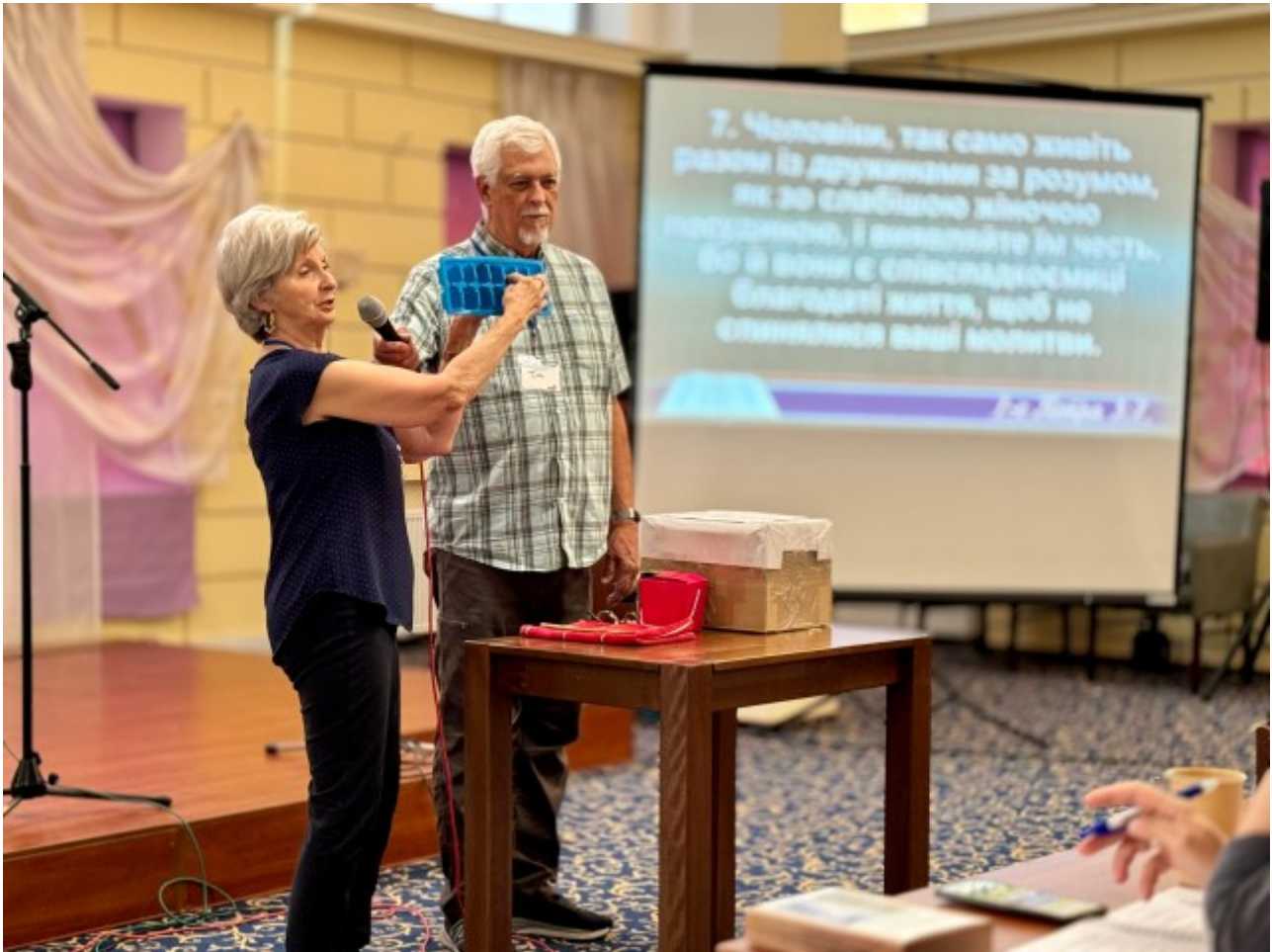
